Downtown Library Affordable Housing Project is being jointly developed by Eden Housing and For the Future Housing, as well as the City of Santa Cruz for the public use components. This development will provide the community with much-needed affordable housing, a modern library, quality childcare facilities and parking for residents, library patrons and visitors to the Downtown area.

Project Overview:

- Single, eight-story building
- 239 public parking spaces
- Located in the heart of downtown Santa Cruz with close proximity to abundance of amenities
- 124 affordable apartments include:
 - Studio units
 - One-bedroom units
 - Two-bedroom units
 - Three-bedroom units
 - One unit for a live-in property manager, ensuring that the property is well managed
- This project also includes:
 - A new Downtown Library
 - Childcare facility
 - Commercial tenant space

Amenities:

- Courtyard
- Playground & picnic area
- Laundry facilities
- Computer Lab

Sustainability Features:

- Solar panels on the roof
- Low-flow water fixtures
- Stormwater retention system
- All electric
