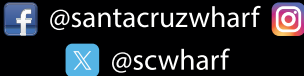

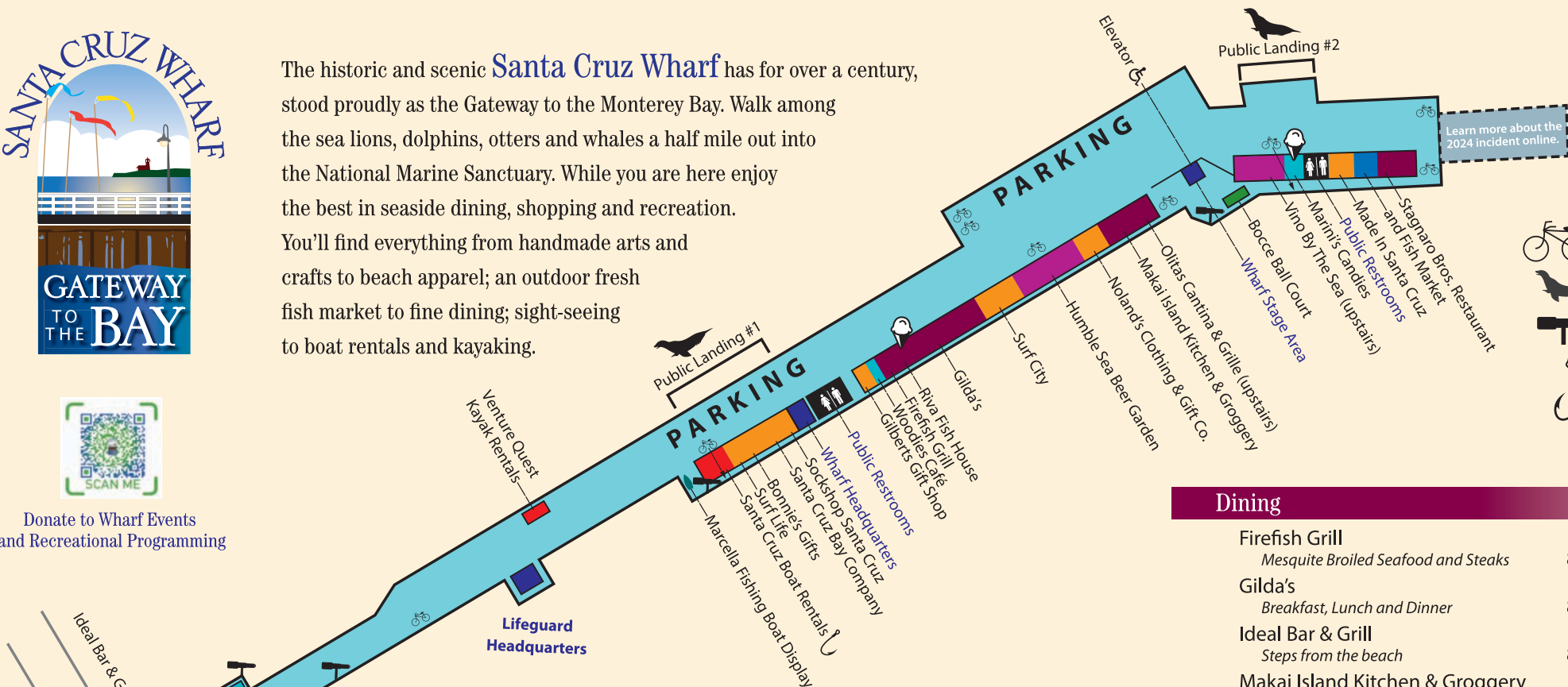

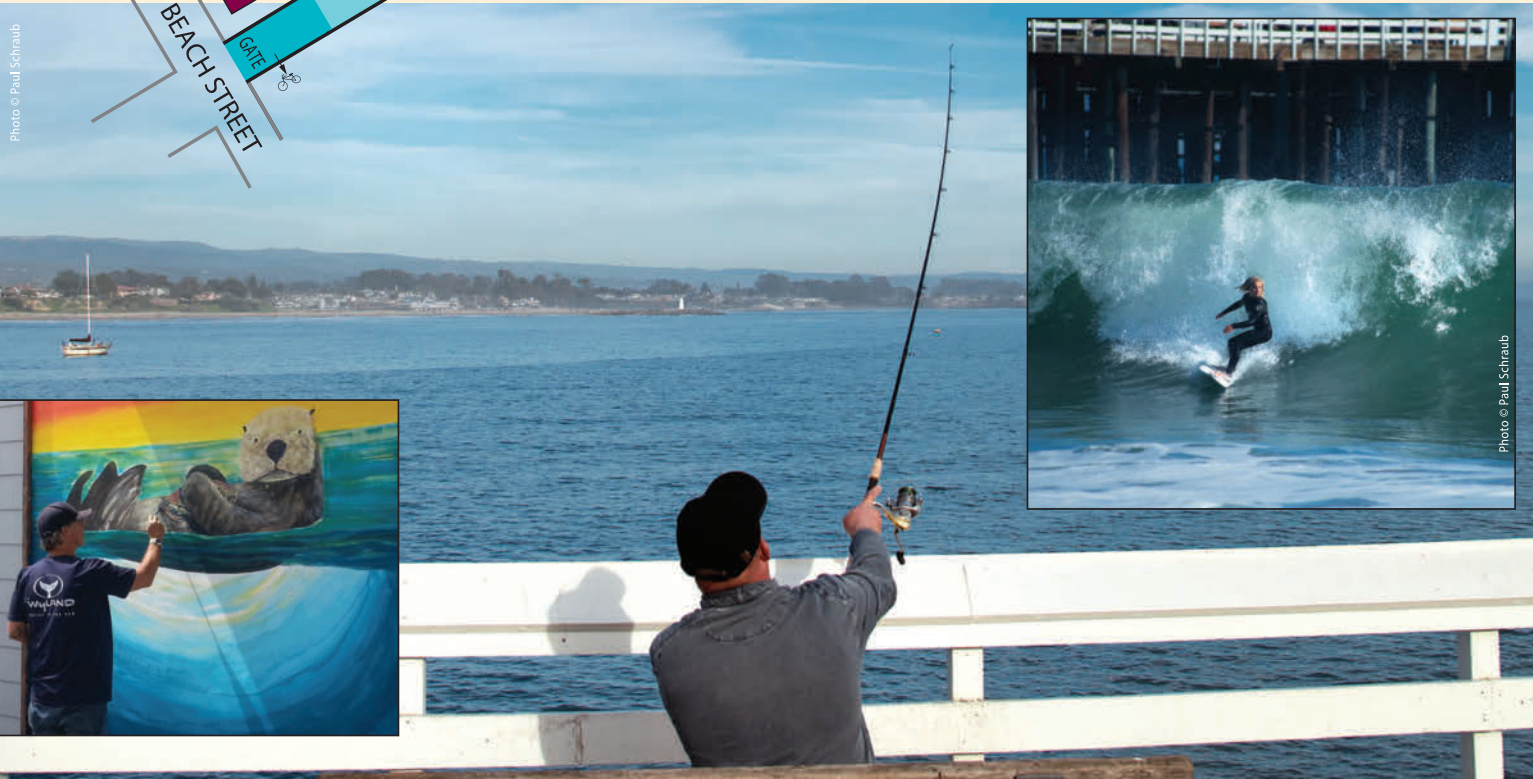
Donate to Wharf Events and Recreational Programming
