The early owner was Arden Hall, a carpenter who arrived in Santa Cruz in about 1869 with his wife, Julia. The house was inherited by Hall's daughter, Helen Emily Hall. Emily Hall married Fred Howe in 1899 and by 1902, they were living in the subject residence. In 1904, Fred Howe instigated substantial street improvements on California Street by installing a sidewalk in front of his house and the City graded the street at that time as well. Howe served as Santa Cruz's Mayor from 1915-1917 and was appointed Postmaster in 1921. Emily died in 1914, and in 1916 Howe married Vernie Violet White, and then later married Ilma Fargo McPherson, all while retaining ownership of the property. In the late 1930s, Howe was Director of the Greater Santa Cruz Oil Corporation. This company was formed with the anticipation of finding and selling oil in DeLaVeaga Park. In testament to his contributions to the City, the Sentinel devoted half of the front page to him at the time of his death in 1948. Following Howe's ownership, the house was acquired by Charles Wheat in the 1950s and later William Robinson, who constructed an addition to the residence in 1977. (Continued on page 4, DPR523L)


